- Introduction Talk We will give a detailed introductory talk on both the company and the upcoming programme.
- Bush Walk Experience the African bush on foot. We will focus on various aspects, such as tracking, bush lore and navigation.

- Reserve Work We will go out into the reserve and conduct basic reserve maintenance, such as clearing elephant damage off the roads, cutting back branches, repairing mitre drains, erosion prevention and alien vegetation removal, as well as learning the importance and sustainability of maintaining the reserves infrastructure.
- Rest Day A day where one can relax around the pool, catch up on personal work and have a must deserved break.
- Prepare Talk Students will be tested on their ability to talk to a group, by giving a fun presentation on a chosen subject.
- **Braai** Students will assist one of the supervisors with a traditional braai (barbeque), which is prepared for all the volunteers/students.
- Lodge Experience A day will be spent gaining valuable experience, working behind the scenes at a neighbouring lodge.
- Star Gazing An interactive star gazing experience of the incredible African night sky.
- First Aid Practical We will setup various scenarios to test the students first aid knowledge and ability to work under pressure.
